Investigation Results in Two Arrests for Pharmacy B&Es January 21, 2012

Jacksonville Police Detectives have charged Elizabeth Price, 25, of Canady Road and Timothy Chatman, 25, of Davis Street after a detailed investigation into Breaking and Entering cases at three Jacksonville pharmacies.

The JPD Investigative Services Division has been investigating a series of B&E's and attempted B&Es to pharmacies in the past several weeks. The businesses are: Northwoods Drug, 344 Henderson Drive; Johnson Drug 714 New Bridge Street and Realo, 3050 Henderson Drive.

Price and Chatman were taken into custody today without incident. Their charges are as listed below. They are incarcerated at the Onslow County Jail on secured bonds. Additional charges are anticipated with regard to the drugs taken from the businesses.
