- Park Shelter - \$20 for first 2 hours (2 hr minimum) and \$5 for each additional hour. Payment due at time of reservation.
- Park for Special Event - Prices vary, please call 938-5312 for details.
- Reservations cannot be confirmed until forms & permits are approved. Final payment must be made no later than 2 weeks prior to event.
- Inclement weather -Reservations may be rescheduled, based on availability, if the Administrative Office is contacted within 3 working days of the original reservation.
