



Welcome to Jacksonville Transit! Important Rider Information

To make your ride more enjoyable, please observe the following rules:

- Wait at only designated stops or, if on Tarawa Terrace or Midway Park, near an intersection.
- Always be at your bus stop a few minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive.
- Signal the driver when waiting at a bus stop.
- Use caution when boarding the bus.
- Passengers are required to wear a shirt and footwear at all times while on the bus.
- Pets (except for service animals and small pets in carriers), bicycles, and smoking are not permitted on board buses.
- Passengers are not allowed to smoke, bring open containers of food, drink, or alcohol on the bus.
- Yelling or using profanity will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the bus.
- Please use care when carrying items such as umbrellas or large packages.
- Playing of radios, CD players, and other similar devices is prohibited unless using earphones and then at a volume not heard by other riders.
- Drivers will announce stops or major intersections.
- Do not carry on a conversation with the bus driver.
- When ready to get off the bus, signal the driver by pulling on the stop pull cord.
- Use caution when exiting the bus.
- Wait until the bus leaves and watch for traffic before crossing the street.
- Please note that Jacksonville Transit operates on US Marine bases at Camp Lejeune, New River Air Station and Camp Johnson. **Only authorized personnel are permitted on base.** Violators of this policy risk being detained by Military Police.
