

### **Section 133. Interpretation, etc. of Ordinance.**

In interpreting and applying the provisions of this ordinance they shall be held to be minimum requirements for the promotion of the public safety, health, convenience, prosperity, and general welfare. It is not intended by this ordinance to interfere with or abrogate or annul any easements, covenants, or other agreements between parties; provided, however, that where this ordinance imposes a greater restriction upon the use of buildings or premises or upon the height of buildings, or requires larger open spaces than are imposed or required by other ordinances, rules, regulations, or by easements, covenants, or agreements, the provisions of this ordinance shall govern; provided, that nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to amend or repeal any provision of this code or other ordinance of the City relating to maintenance or keeping of horses or livestock or animals within the corporate limits.
