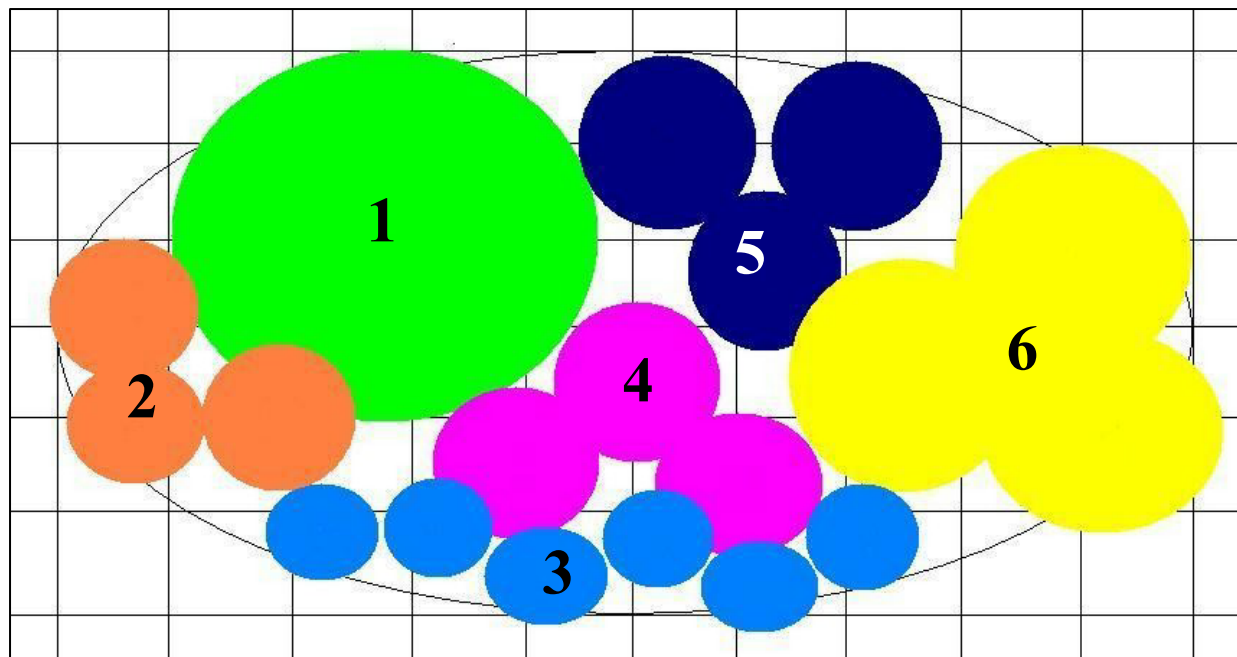


Oval Rain Garden



- 1 – 1 small tree or tree form shrub
- 2 – 3 perennials or ornamental grasses
- 3 – 6 small perennials or groundcovers
- 4 – 3 perennials
- 5 – 3 large perennials or ornamental grasses
- 6 – 3 small shrubs

- Each square equals one square foot

Dry = Very Sandy, ponding only a few hours **Average** = Ponding for 1 to 2 days

Wet = Always moist, ponding for 3 or more days
