Motorcyclist Charged After High Speed Pursuit June 15, 2010

Jacksonville Police have arrested Travis Manley, 28, of 1211 Pueblo Drive after a high-speed chase last night.

At approximately 9:00 PM on Monday, June 14th, Jacksonville Police Officer Jeremy Tarrant attempted to conduct a traffic stop on a motorcycle operating with no license plate at the intersection of New River Drive and Hargett Street in the city. The suspect refused to heed the lights and siren and proceeded from the Hargett Street area to Bell Fork Road, Country Club Road and Piney Green Road, operating the motorcycle at a high rate of speed. The suspect continued to Pueblo Drive in the Hunter's Creek subdivision, where he abandoned the motorcycle and fled on foot into a wooded area.

Officers pursued the suspect and Jacksonville Police K-9 Officer Marcus Brown and his dog Loco were able to apprehend him. Deputies from the Onslow County Sheriff's department assisted at the scene. Manley is held at the Onslow County Jail. Charges are as listed below.
