### **Vehicle B&E Arrest Made**

May 9, 2010

Jacksonville Police responded to the Stop and Pawn on Lejeune Blvd at 8:20 PM on Saturday, May 9<sup>th</sup> in reference to a breaking and entering to vehicle in progress. Officers arrived to discover that the subject had broken into the vehicle. Witnesses reported that subject fled the area and was seen in the area of Rainbow Drive. K-9 Officer Brown located the suspect, Travis Javaun Lee, 18 of Old 30 Road. The suspect was taken into custody and charged (as detailed below). Lee is held at the Onslow County Jail under \$5,500 secured bond.

The same evening, at approximately 10:30 PM, Jacksonville Police officers responded to several reports of breaking and larceny from vehicles at the Carmike Cinemas, at the Jacksonville Mall. Witnesses observed two juveniles breaking into vehicles parked at the business. Police officers apprehended one juvenile, while another fled the scene. The case remains under investigation.
