### **Police Release Sketch of Suspect Friday, June 4, 2010**

Jacksonville Police Department have released a sketch of a suspect sought in the May 19, 2010 fatal shooting incident on Onslow Drive that resulted in the death of Ramel L. McDonald, 30, of Bryan Street, Jacksonville.

The suspect in this incident is described as a black male in his early to mid 20's. The suspect had short hair, was wearing a black fitted ball cap, approximately 5'10 to 6'00 tall with a medium to slender build. He was wearing white t-shirt, and jeans. The suspect was seen at the time of the incident with a semi-automatic handgun.

The Police Department has requested that anyone that may have information about this incident or suspect to continue to contact the Jacksonville/Onslow Crime Stoppers at 910-938-3273 or Jacksonville Police Department Detective Kaderbek at 910-455-4000.

Crime Stoppers of Onslow County is offering a reward of up to \$2,500 for information leading to an arrest or apprehension in the case.
