Police Investigate Overnight Vehicle Thefts June 29, 2010

Jacksonville Police Department is investigating the theft of two vehicles that occurred during the evening of June 28th or early morning hours of June 29, 2010.

Jacksonville Police responded to a report of a stolen roll-back tow truck (1986 GMC) from Modern Tire Service, 606 Richlands Highway. Employees reported that the truck was last accounted for at 9:30 PM on the evening of June 28th. The truck was discovered missing when the employees reported to work at 6:45 AM on June 29th. The truck is blue in color and carried a NC Vehicle Plate CH8863 at the time it was stolen.

Police are also investigating the theft of a 1968 Chevrolet Camaro stolen from the 1000 block of Commons Drive (North) in the Jacksonville Commons area of the City. The vehicle was stolen from the driveway of a residence sometime between 11:30 PM on June 28th and 7:00 AM on June 29, 2010. The car is blue in color and had a North Carolina license plate of JE 68 at the time it was stolen.
